

Using ProQuest Ebook Central at Photography Studies College

ProQuest Ebook Central can be accessed on campus or remotely through the Research Hub Databases web page (<https://go.psc.edu.au/thehub/databases/>). Any texts in the prescribed and recommended reading lists of Photography Studies College's unit outlines that are available from Ebook Central have also been added to the Hub Catalogue (<https://library.psc.edu.au>).

Username and Passwords

Your username and password for the Databases webpage are the same that you use to access the PSC Network. For Ebook Central, once you register at our Ebook Central website (<http://ebookcentral.proquest.com/auth/lib/pscaw/requestAccount.action>) your user name and password will be sent to the email address you provided.

Browsing an E-Book

You can browse an e-book for up to five minutes before being prompted to choose whether to borrow it.

Borrowing an E-Book

You can borrow up to five e-books per week. Each loan is for the period of one day.

Requesting an E-Book

PSC subscribes to over 6,000 titles from the Ebook Central range. Where feasible, Hub staff may provide access to other e-books from the Ebook Central range on request, when it can be demonstrated that the text is relevant for teaching or learning.

Copying and Pasting from an E-Book

For copyright reasons there are restrictions on how much text you can copy and paste from an e-book. In most cases this is 5% of the total text.

Printing an E-Book

Most e-books will allow you to print only one chapter, or 10% of a title.

Downloading a chapter or book as a PDF

To download at home you will need to have first installed Adobe Acrobat Reader.
